

## Bohemian and continental

Why was a town established in Gjøvik? Glass factory founder Caspar Kauffeldt, who built the large, white limed building at the center Gjøvik Gård in 1810, is partially responsible. Today you can come visit the Mjøen family's original and lavish home from the last half of the 19th century. Here the town's history is explored, from glass and industry to aquavit and potatoes, centered around the notable people who have lived in Gjøvik Gård. Gjøvik Gård is located in the beautiful park, right in the town center, nearby hotels and Skibladner's dock. The cozy Kafé Drengestua serves a selection of cakes and simple lunches on offer.
