Spring 2016: Documentation and collecting

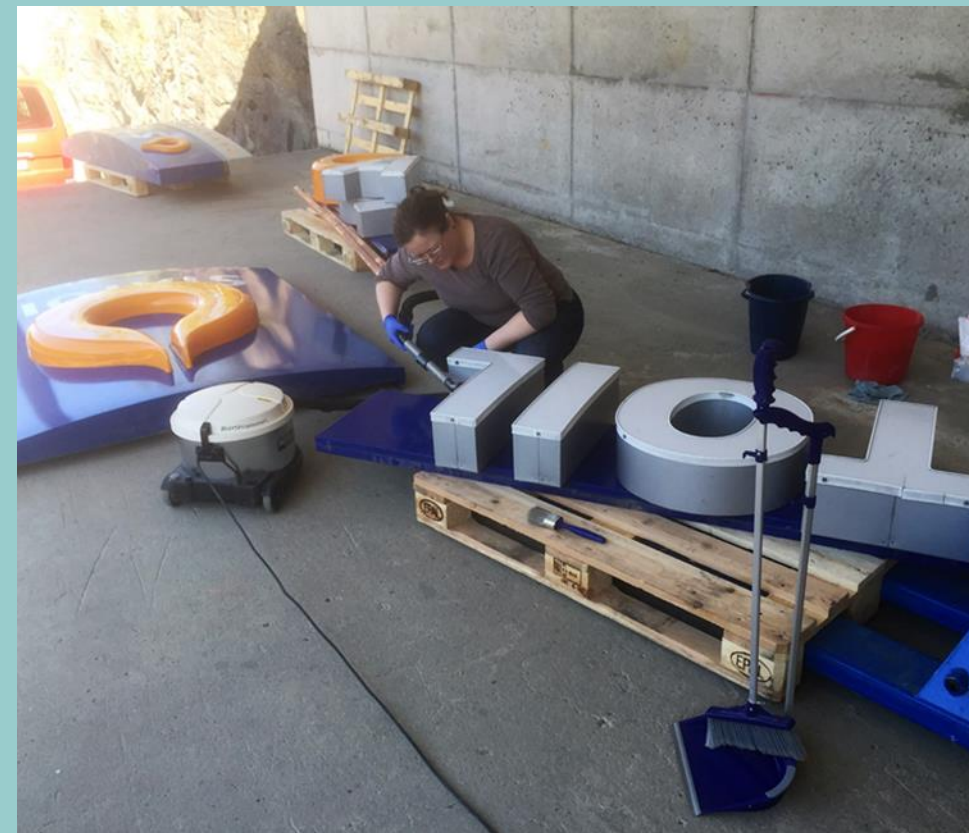
